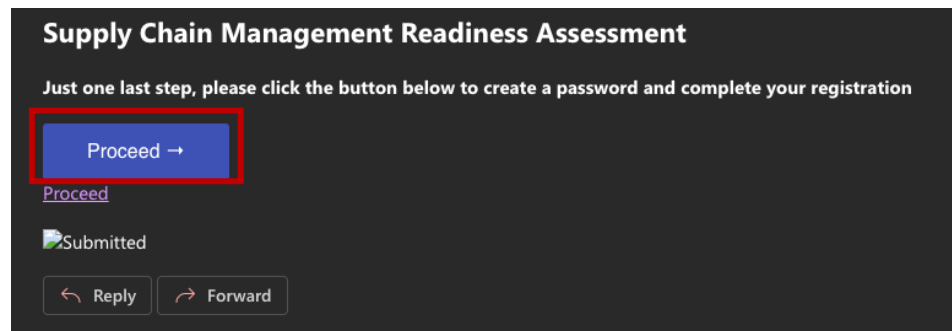





### 2.1 Once registered, proceed to login


On successful registration, you will be redirect. For convenience, this link redirects to the login page as well: [Click link](#)

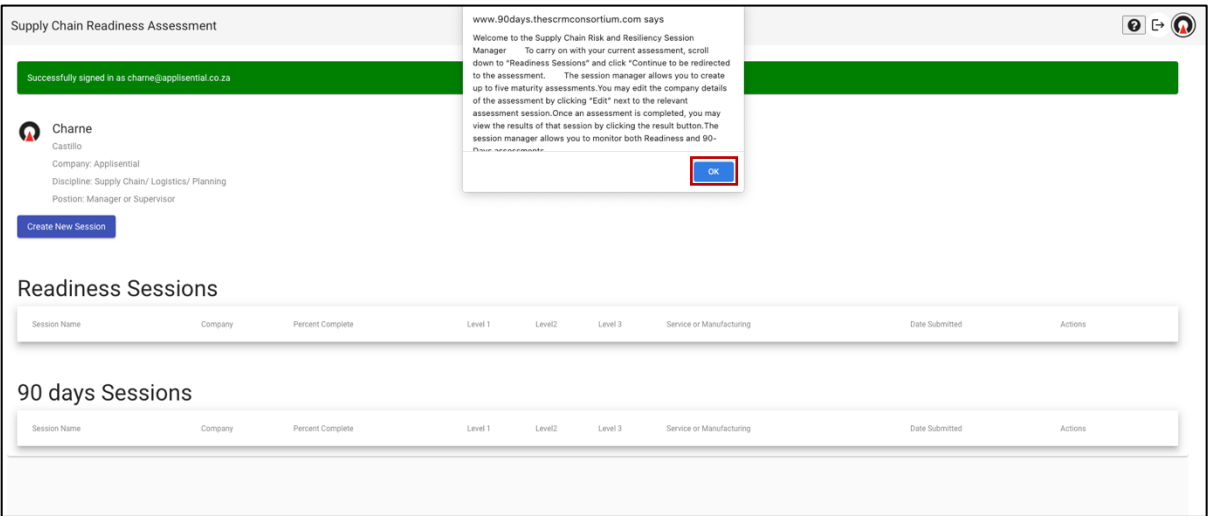

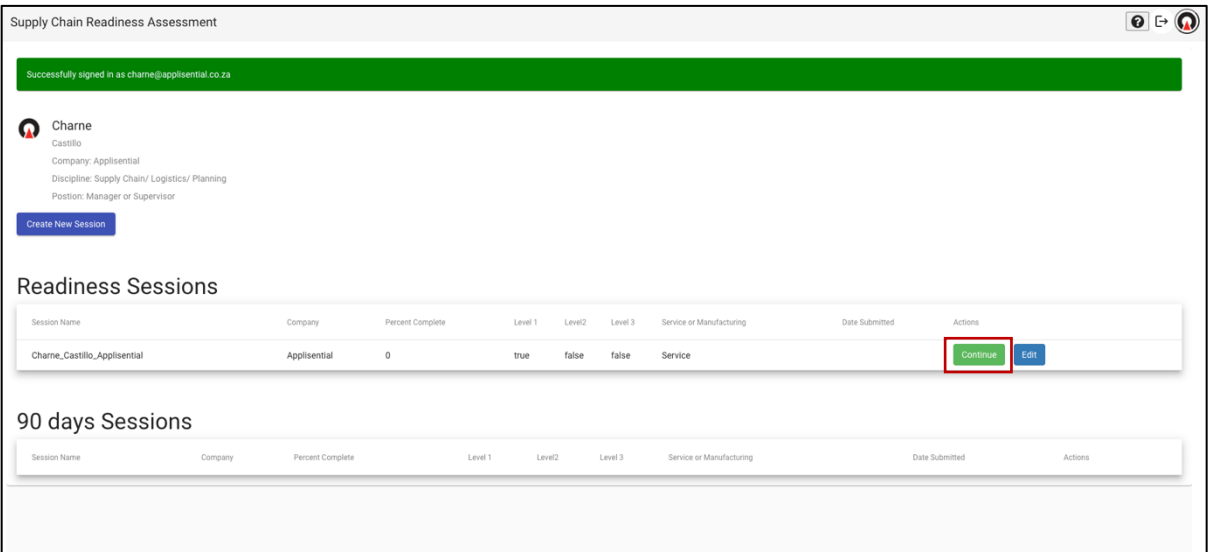
## 2.2 Returning to the assessment

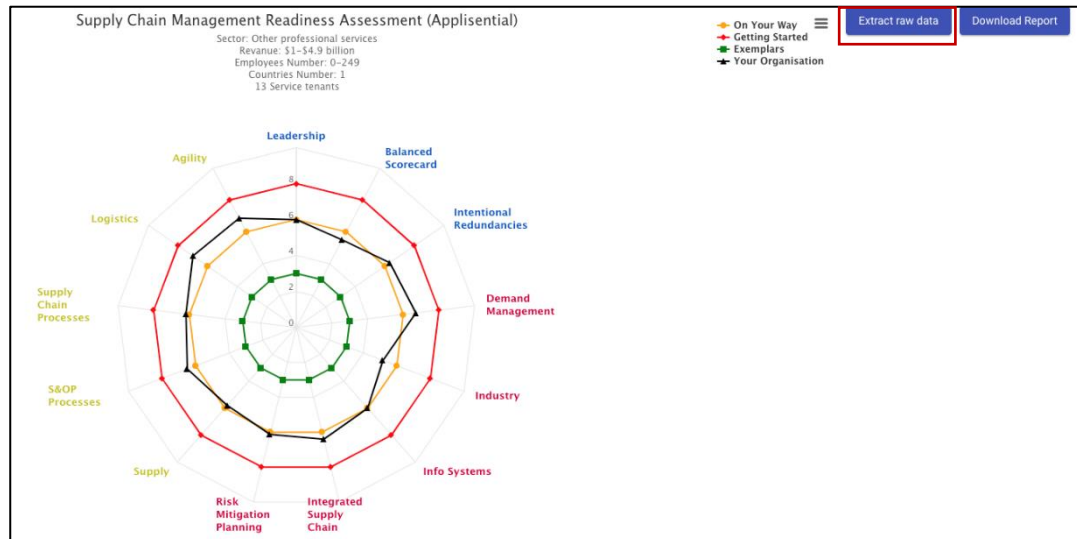

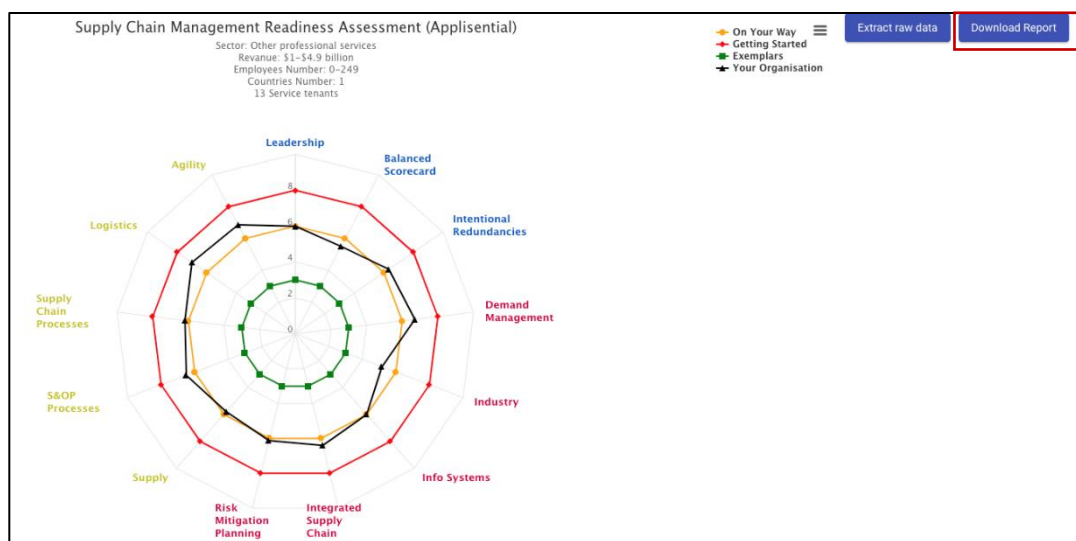
## 4.2 How do I see my responses?
